Definition of Other jobs in addition to choir

Servers – This program is a seated dinner theater; therefore, all tables will be assigned a server. Servers are responsible for their table's needs, including refilling drinks, making sure everyone receives the correct meal, and clearing the table.

Food Runners – Food will be delivered to the servers in the Sanctuary by food runners. You will need to be ready to do a lot of walking and carry multiple plates of food on a tray.

Kitchen Staff – Behind the scenes, the kitchen team is responsible for plating food. The choir is discouraged from this job; the food will be plated during musical portions of the program.

Clean-up Team – Responsible for collecting the dirty dishes from servers and end of program clean-up. Performers will not be able to do this job as it takes place during the music portion of the program. Kitchen staff are welcome to join the clean-up team after they are done with preparing the food.

Ticket Sales

All sales will require a ticket order form. Acceptable forms of payment include Cash, Credit, PayPal and Check payable to Pleasant Hills UMC. Electronic forms of payment will be only available when purchased online.

Children 5 and under are free – they may watch the show or use free childcare provided.

Unless you are a performer, volunteer or child under 5, a ticket must be purchased. There is not an option to buy a ticket at a reduced cost to only watch the show. The show is entertainment for those who are purchasing a dinner ticket.

Day of Event

Volunteers may have earlier call times, but the choir should arrive no later than 5:30PM.

Dress will be white top with black bottoms OR all black. Ties, scarfs, or other accent pieces should be purple, burgundy, or wine colored.
